If your combined skill level is higher than 10 on the day of the event, you'll have to pick a new partner.

We will use your highest "session-ending" handicap in the past league year (from summer 2018 until now).

If you've played in the current session for several weeks as a skill level higher than what you ended summer as, we may require you to play at that higher level, since that's very likely what will be required in Vegas.

Just because we allow you to sign up does NOT mean you will be allowed to play together; check your skill levels!
