

Team Captains Tournament Rules—LOCAL RULES 2021 ONLY

1. Thanks for coming today! Have fun! Excellent sportsmanship is #1!
 2. No earphones
 3. Use the bracket board to see who, where and when you play next. **It is your responsibility to check the board when you arrive at the tournament to make sure you appear on the board. Over 5 minutes late for any match = forfeit. WE WILL NOT COME FIND YOU OR CALL YOU TO REMIND YOU WHEN AND WHERE YOU ARE PLAYING; YOU MUST CHECK THE BOARD. Times are outlined on the board NOW, and table numbers will appear about 10 minutes before each scheduled start time.**
 4. 2-person teams. Maximum combined skill level limit of 10 at the time you signed up. Skill levels we use for this tournament are 8-Ball skill levels as of about 5 days prior to the event. If a player isn't on an 8-Ball team, or if he/she hasn't played 8-Ball in a significant period of time, we will use the player's 9-Ball skill level (League Operator's discretion).
 5. **Alternate shot.** After you pocket a ball, it's now your partner's turn to try. Take turns each shot, even from game to game. So, if you win one game, your partner breaks on the next game.
 6. No talking to your partner while he/she is shooting. **One time out per rack, but KEEP THEM QUICK... one minute maximum.**
 7. At the very beginning of the match, flip a coin to see which team breaks first.
 8. Play one game of **9-Ball first**, followed by a game of 8-Ball, then back to 9-Ball again, and so on... 9-Ball MUST BE played first. No exceptions.
 9. No need to mark innings or ball points. Simply use the score-sheet provided at the registration table to keep track of how many games each team has won. Use the "Games Must Win" on the back of this paper to determine how many games you and your partner must win.
 10. For the purposes of this tournament, in 9-Ball – **making the 9-Ball is a win** (not tracking points today).
 11. Modified single elim. today—guarantees that every team gets to play twice, but not necessarily lose twice.
 12. If you win today, you progress to Vegas for the National Team Captains Championship, August 8th through August 11th.
 13. If you make it to Vegas, the format there will be much different than today (see attached). You will be asked to pick 1-3 additional Captains to join you. We need you to make this determination by the end of June. Teams in Vegas for the Team Captain Championship are 3-5 people. All people on your 3-5 person Vegas team must meet the following criteria:
 - A. Must have been a Team Captain in both Fall 2020 and Spring 2021.
 - B. Must have 20 or more matches in ONE FORMAT (either 8-Ball or 9-Ball) before August. Combining matches from 8-Ball and 9-Ball doesn't count.
 - C. Must remain on a summer 2021 team.
- Choose your team wisely because the 3 people who play in any given round in Las Vegas cannot exceed 15 (and max of one SL6 per round).
14. Winning team gets their travel money when they arrive to Vegas. The money will be distributed solely to the 2 people who win the local event.
 15. Payout is 100% payback of all entry fees plus \$500 added to the purse by the League Office.
