Important Notice Regarding Last Week of Play

Divisions with 8 or More Teams

Tonight is the last week of regular play. ALL teams still have a chance to get into Playoffs with the Wildcard Draw. Here's how it works:

- After we receive tonight's scoresheets, final points are calculated. The team with the highest points is the Division Champion. They get an automatic spot in Northern Nevada APA Championships (formerly called LTC's). The next 3 highest teams (points) get into Playoffs, in addition to a Wildcard Team. The Wildcard Team is drawn at random (see below).
- Teams already qualified for the Championships are exempt (in a good way) from Playoffs.
- The Wildcard Team is selected at random via the roll of a dice. <u>ALL TEAMS who are up to date with weekly dues will have a chance to win the Wildcard Draw</u>. The Wildcard Draw date & time will be sent via email within 1-2 days of that final regular-season match. The Wildcard Draw will be conducted via Facebook Live on our Private Facebook Group called "Northern Nevada APA Players."
- We will e-mail everyone in the Division regarding which teams made it to Playoffs, in addition
 to which team won the Wildcard Draw. If you don't check your email frequently, those
 updates will also be posted on the League Website at
 http://NorthernNevada.apaleagues.com. Just look under "Latest News" on that main page.
- During the first week of Playoffs, the highest seeded team plays the Wildcard team, while the second highest seeded team plays the third seeded team. Winners progress to the second/final week of Playoffs.
- Winner of the final week of Playoffs also gets a spot in the Championships.
- All Playoff matches take place at the higher-seeded team's home location.

REMINDERS REGARDING PLAYOFF MATCHES:

- → Forfeits during 8-Ball Playoff Matches are scored as 3-0 (instead of the normal 2-0 for an 8-Ball forfeit). Forfeits during 9-Ball Playoff Matches are scored as 20-0 (instead of the normal 15-0 for a 9-Ball forfeit).
- → Full weekly dues of \$50 are required, regardless of the # of matches played.
- → When one team reaches a point where it's mathematically impossible for the other team to win, teams may choose to end of the league night match. That's up to you. Some teams will still play all 5 players just to give all players a chance to play and earn patches, etc. If you are using the Scorekeeping App, the App will not allow you to continue scoring once your team gets to a point where the other team cannot mathematically win. So, if you want to play it out, come equipped with a hard copy scoresheet.
- → In the rare case of a tie during a Playoff match, the tie-breaker is determined by the team who had the most players win that night.
