Important Notice Regarding Last Week of Play:

Division Less Than 8 Teams

Tonight is the last week of regular play. Here's how Playoffs will work for this division:

- After we receive tonight's scoresheets, final points will be calculated.
- Any teams who are already qualified for the Northern Nevada APA Championships (formerly called LTC's) are exempt (in a good way) from Playoffs.
- Of the remaining teams, the top team (points) will play against the Wildcard Team (see next bullet), while the 2nd place team will play against the 3rd place team. Winners of those two matches will progress to the 2nd week of Playoffs. The team who ultimately wins Playoffs will earn a spot at the Northern NV APA Championships.
- The Wildcard Team is selected at random via the roll of a dice. <u>ALL TEAMS who are up to date with weekly dues will have a chance to win the Wildcard Draw</u>. The Wildcard Draw date & time will be sent via email within 1-2 days of that final regular-season match. The Wildcard Draw will be conducted via Facebook Live on our Private Facebook Group called "Northern Nevada APA Players." Teams are welcome to tune in, but teams are NOT required to be watching to win.
- We will e-mail everyone in the Division regarding which teams made it to Playoffs, in addition
 to which team won the Wildcard Draw. If you don't check your email frequently, those
 updates will also be posted on the League Website at
 http://NorthernNevada.apaleagues.com. Just look under "Latest News" on that main page.
- All Playoff matches take place at the higher-seeded team's home location.

REMINDERS REGARDING PLAYOFF MATCHES:

- → Forfeits during 8-Ball Playoff Matches are scored as 3-0 (instead of the normal 2-0 for an 8-Ball forfeit). Forfeits during 9-Ball Playoff Matches are scored as 20-0 (instead of the normal 15-0 for a 9-Ball forfeit).
- → Full weekly dues of \$50 are required, regardless of the # of matches played.
- → When one team reaches a point where it's mathematically impossible for the other team to win, teams may choose to end of the league night match. That's up to you. Some teams will still play all 5 players just to give all players a chance to play and earn patches, etc. If you are using the Scorekeeping App, the App will not allow you to continue scoring once your team gets to a point where the other team cannot mathematically win. So, if you want to play it out, come equipped with a hard copy scoresheet.
- → In the rare case of a tie during a Playoff match, the tie-breaker is determined by the team who had the most players win that night.
