Northern NV APA Ladies Tournament Rules

- 1. Thanks for coming today! Have fun! Excellent sportsmanship is #1!
- 2. The tournament will be run today, following the "modified single elimination" format that is used at most major APA Regional and National tournaments. This format ensures that every team gets to PLAY at least 2 times (but *not* necessarily lose twice).
- 3. This is an "ON-CALL" tournament. This means that you must be available to play at all times whenever we announce that your team is up.
- 4. The format of this tournament is just like league night, but with 3 people instead of 5.
- 5. 3-person teams. Maximum combined SL of 13. The 3 ladies on any one team must have a combined skill level of 13 or lower on the day we run the report for the tournament (which is typically 5-7 days before the event). Just because we allow you to sign up together doesn't mean you'll be allowed to play together. If someone's skill level increases in between the time they sign up and that day we run the report to prepare for the tournament, thereby resulting in a combined SL greater than 13, that team wouldn't be permitted to play together.
- 6. All participating players must be on an active 8-Ball Northern NV APA roster.
- 7. At the beginning of the match, lag to see who breaks (just like league night).
- 8. We will COMMONLY be playing TWO tables simultaneously. If your match is assigned two tables, this is required (not optional).
- 9. Use the score-sheet provided at the registration table. <u>CIRCLE THE WINNER!!!</u>
- 10. One total time-out per player per rack even for SL 2's and 3's (which is different than league night). Remember just like regular rules if anyone on your team SUGGESTS or even MENTIONS a time-out to your shooter, she will be charged with a time-out.
- 11. We use the 3-point scoring system today, just like league night.
 - 1. Player A wins with a shutout; they win 3-0.
 - 2. If Player A wins, but Player B wins a game, Player A gets 2-0.
 - 3. If Player A wins, but Player B makes it to the hill, the split is 2-1.

If you get to a point where it's mathematically impossible for the other team to win, then stop. Example, if your first player won 3-0 and your second player won 2-0, you would NOT play the 3rd player at all because there is no way that the other team could win at that point. TURN OVER – 2 PAGES

- 12. No patches today.
- 13. Top 2 teams win cash. 100% payback of all entry fees plus \$500 added by the League Office.
- 14. The majority of the money goes to the winning team to help pay for their trip to Vegas. The winning team will receive this money when they arrive in Vegas. If your team wins, you must stay on an active APA 8-Ball team. Maximum of 5 ladies are allowed on your Vegas team, so think about whether or not you'd want to add 1 or 2 ladies if you end up winning today.

 Just like today, only 3 ladies play per match, but it'd probably be wise to at least have a 4th lady in Vegas. You can strategize better that way, and you can change which 3 Ladies play each round. It's up to you.
